Use questioning with mini-whiteboards

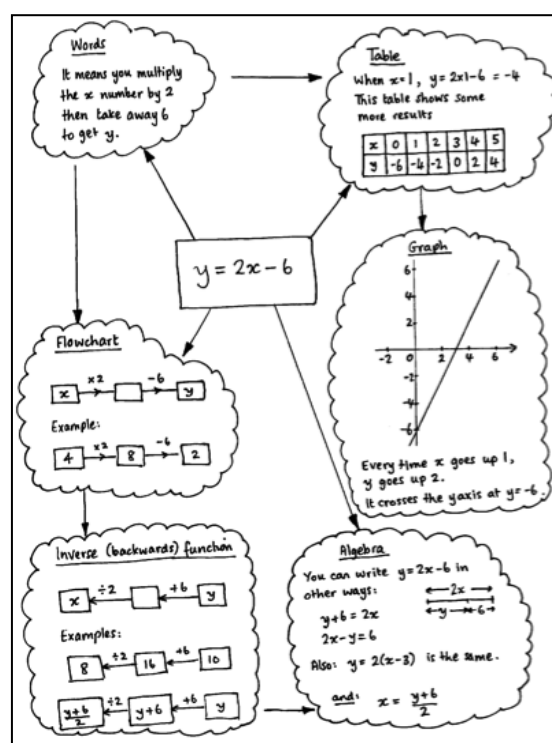
One difficulty with normal classroom questioning is that some students dominate while others are too afraid to participate. In this strategy, every student presents a response simultaneously. When open questions are used, students are able to give different responses to those around the m. The teacher is able to immediately assess which students understand the ideas and which are struggling.



Ask students to produce posters

Ask each small group of students to work together to produce a poster:

- showing their joint solution to a problem
- summarising what they know about a given topic, or
- showing two different ways to solve a given problem.
- showing the connections between a mathematical idea and other related ideas.
